Attention Scouts! The Golden Gate Area Council is looking for a patch design that will represent the new **Pathfinder Hike Series**. This is the new program that the Council is transitioning to from the previous hike programs (The Highland and Rim Rover Series).

Theme:

Pathfinder Hike Program – Celebrating the diverse hiking opportunities in the Golden Gate Area Council

Elements that must be part of the patch design:

- "Pathfinder Hike Program"
- "Golden Gate Area Council"
- A catchphrase (can be like the language from the legacy patches i.e. "An Ongoing Quest" or "Rim of The Bay Progressive Trek")

Design Rules:

- The design must be for a 6 inch diameter round patch (individual hikes will have specific rockers that can be placed around the main patch)
- The design must promote/represent the theme of **"Hiking"**
- Suggested design elements:
 - Landmarks from within the Council (Mt. Diablo, Golden Gate Bridge, Clear Lake, East Bay Hills, San Francisco Bay, Redwoods, Ships, etc.).
 - Scouts – including diversity elements (male/female/ethnicity/age).
 - Items/symbols synonymous with Pathfinder such as "discovery", "exploration", "navigation".
- The design can include up to 12 colors.
